- Course teaching is based on both practical, Tutorial and theoretical parts delivered in various ways (CBL, TBL, flipped classrooms) and various tools to make the students more interested and engaged in the process of learning.
- Creation of standardized rubrics for basic communication skills in collaboration with the Medical Education Unit e.g., patient interview, breaking bad news, dealing with difficult patient, informed consent, confidentiality, conflict management etc...
