

RESEARCH CITATIONS INCENTIVES POLICY

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1. Purpose

The research conducted at the university aims to enrich science and knowledge in all fields and boost the quality of research at FBSU

2. Definitions

The definitions herein appear in this document and/or in the related documents

- 2.1 **The Dean:** the dean of the Scientific Research Deanship
- 2.2 **The Council:** the Scientific Research Council
- 2.3 **The applicant** is the faculty member who applies for publication incentives.
- 2.4 **The incentives** are the financial awards granted to the faculty member for publishing a book, a journal paper, or achieving high citation of scientific work.

3. Policies

- 3.1 An award is disbursed by the university upon the recommendation of the Council for faculty members who have gained high number of citations for his/her publication.
- 3.2 The citations to be considered are only for the year before the application time.
- 3.3 The minimum number of citations for the year should be at least 50 for in order to submit the application requesting the citations incentives.
- 3.4 The applicant should have a paper being published or accepted for publications for the year requesting the citation incentives.
- 3.5 The incentives amount will be 50 times the number of citations acquired at that year with maximum amount of 5,000 SR.
- 3.6 The applicant should file for citations incentives during the third year after his/her appointment at FBSU.
